## ABOUT OUR SPEAKERS

### The Apostles of the Interior Life

The Apostles of the Interior Life are consecrated women who dedicate themselves to evangelization and to offering a service of spiritual assistance for the interior formation of all who seek to know and love Jesus Christ. In the U.S., they have one house at the Newman Center at the University of Illinois in Champaign, and another at the St. Lawrence Catholic Center at the University of Kansas in Lawrence, KS. They also have houses in Italy.

### Father Tait Schroeder

Fr. Schroeder was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Madison on May 24, 2002. He is currently serving as parochial vicar at St. Dennis Catholic Church in Madison. He attended Immaculate Heart of Mary Seminary at St. Mary's University in Winona, MN. After obtaining a B.A. in Philosophy, he completed his seminary studies at the Pontifical North American College in Rome. He has an S.T.B. from the Pontifical University of St. Thomas and an S.T.L. focusing on sacramental theology from the Pontifical Athenaeum of St. Anselm.

### Kristine L. Franklin

Kristine Franklin is a former evangelical missionary and convert to the Catholic Faith. She has contributed articles to many Catholic publications and is a frequent conference speaker. Kristine is also the co-host of the EWTN series, "Household of Faith" and "Now That We're Catholic." Kristine and her husband, Marty, live in Minnesota with their two children.

## COST
