Sister is Professor of Theology at the University of St. Mary of the Lake/Mundelein Seminary (Archdiocese of Chicago) and has taught dogmatic theology to seminarians for over twenty years. She serves on the International Theological Commission and is a consultant to the Pontifical Council for Promoting the New Evangelization and the U.S. Bishops' Committee on Doctrine.
